We have already raised \$1,500 through various efforts, and need a minimum of \$1,500 more to get our team there.

One upcoming event is on October 13th, 2008. It will be a "FRIENDLY SLAM" which will take place at Carleton Place Cinemas from 7 to 10 p.m.
